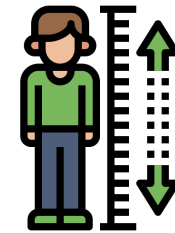
tall

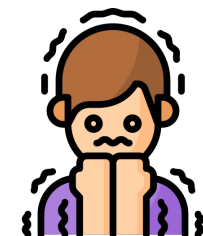

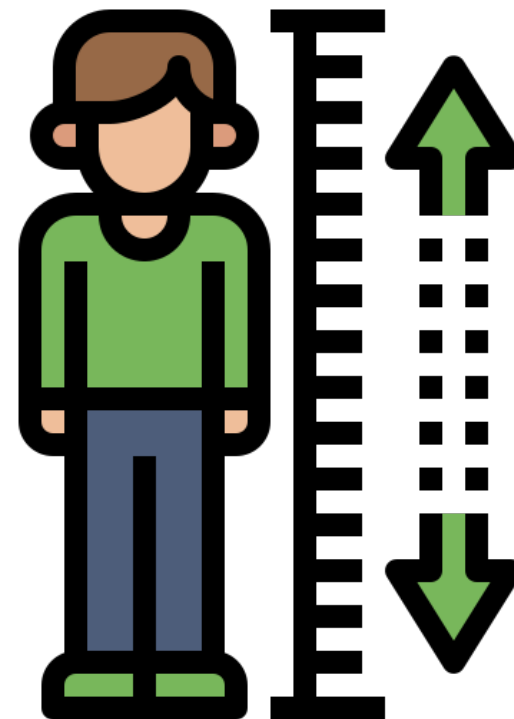
Display Slips
