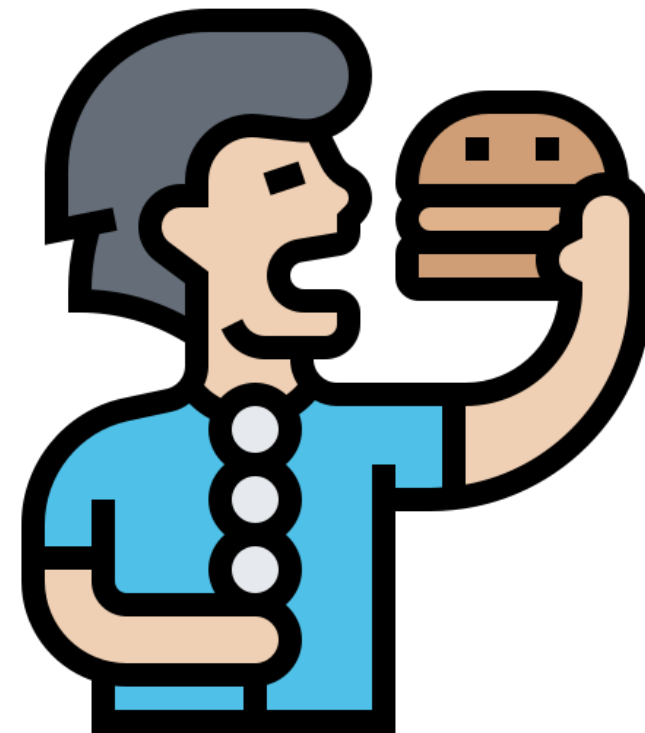
Display Slips

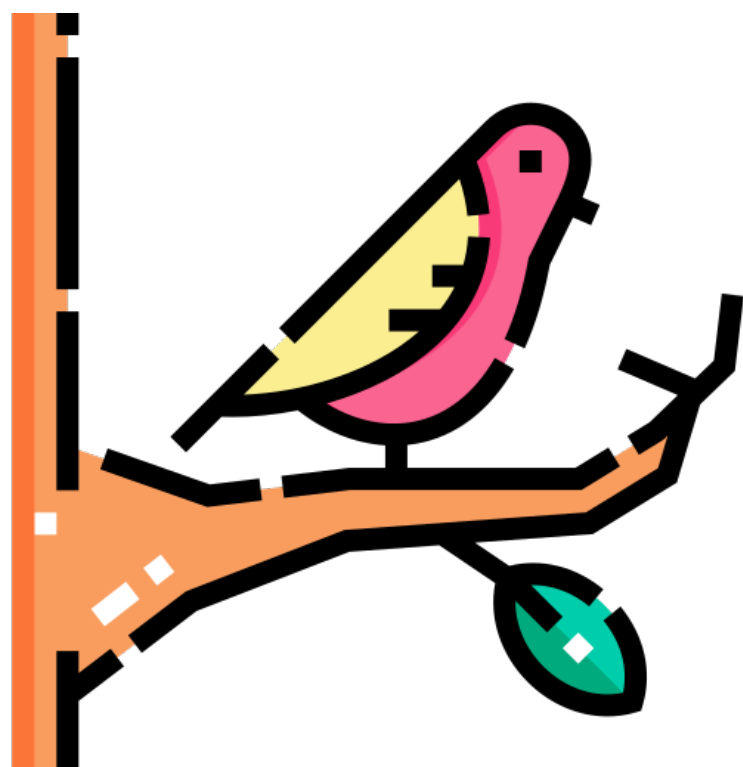

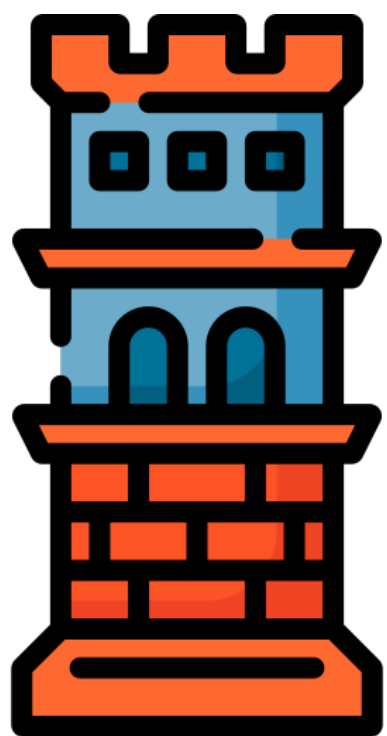
