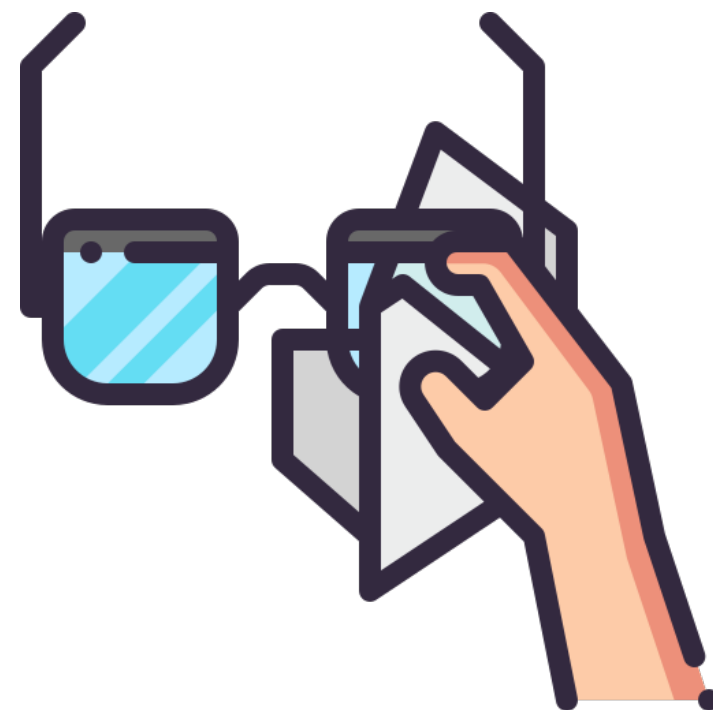
Display Slips

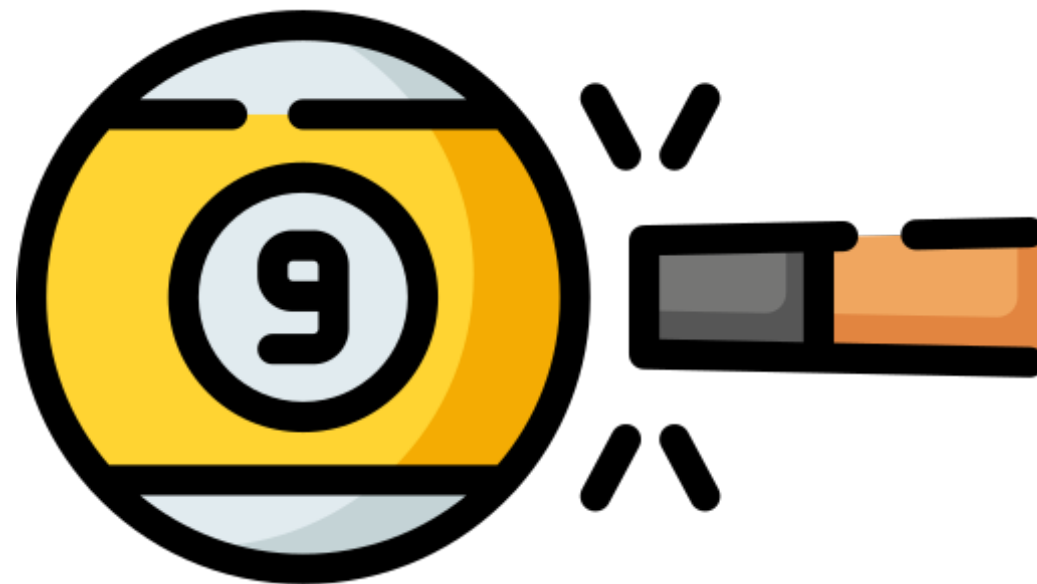

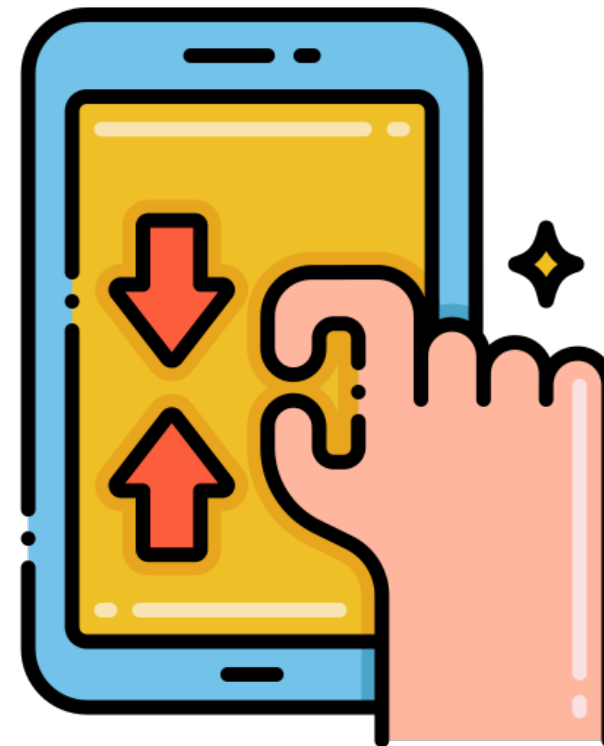

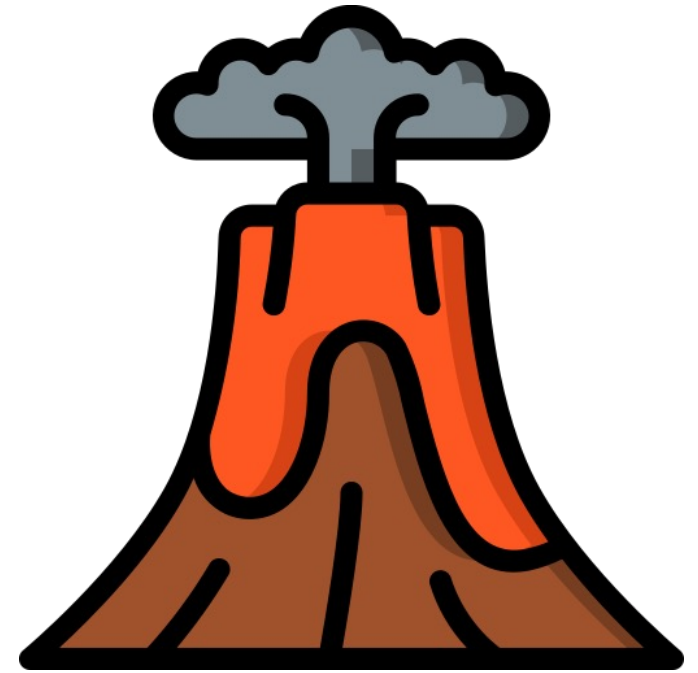
