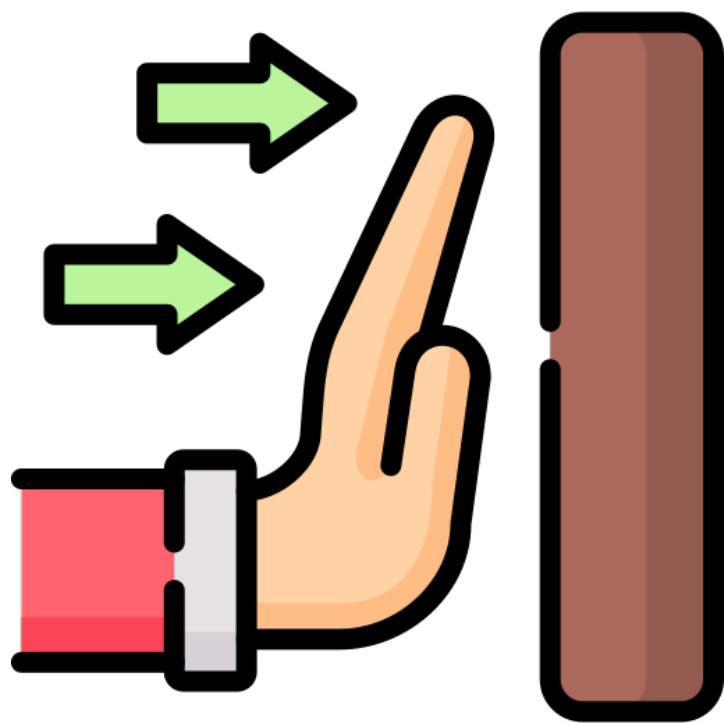
Display Slips

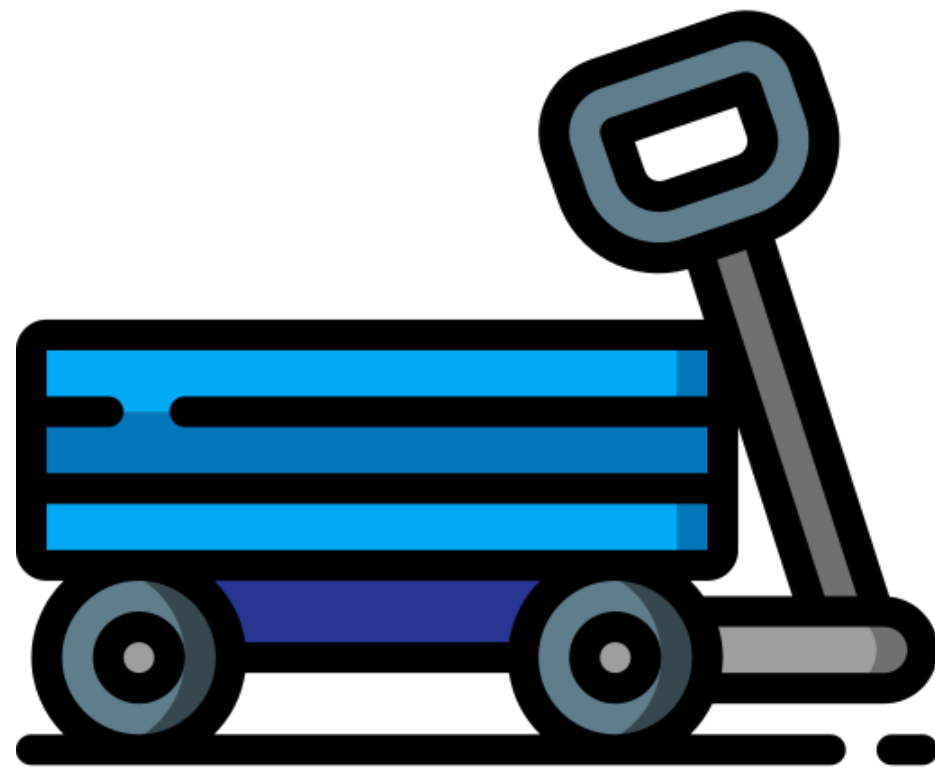

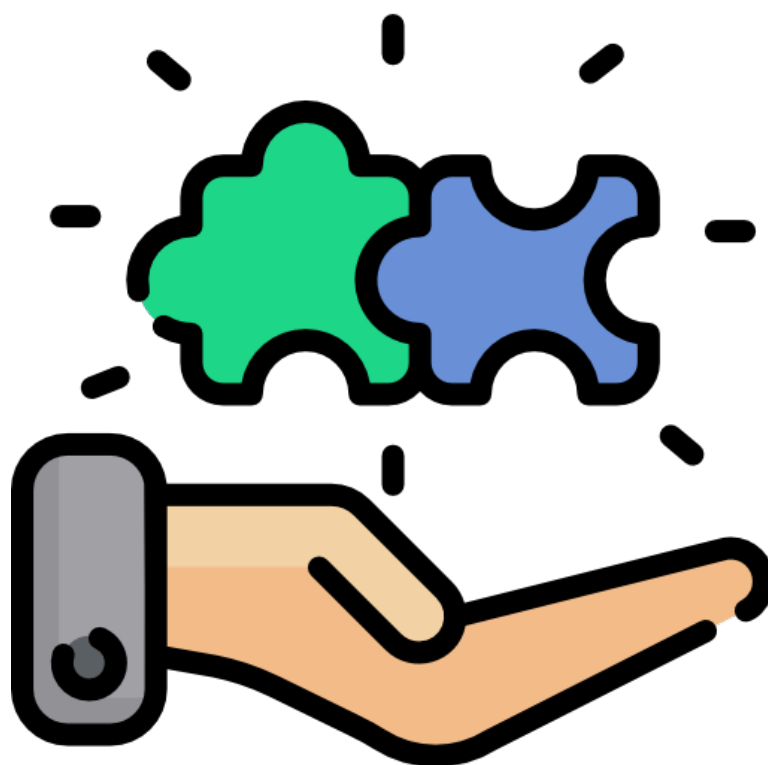

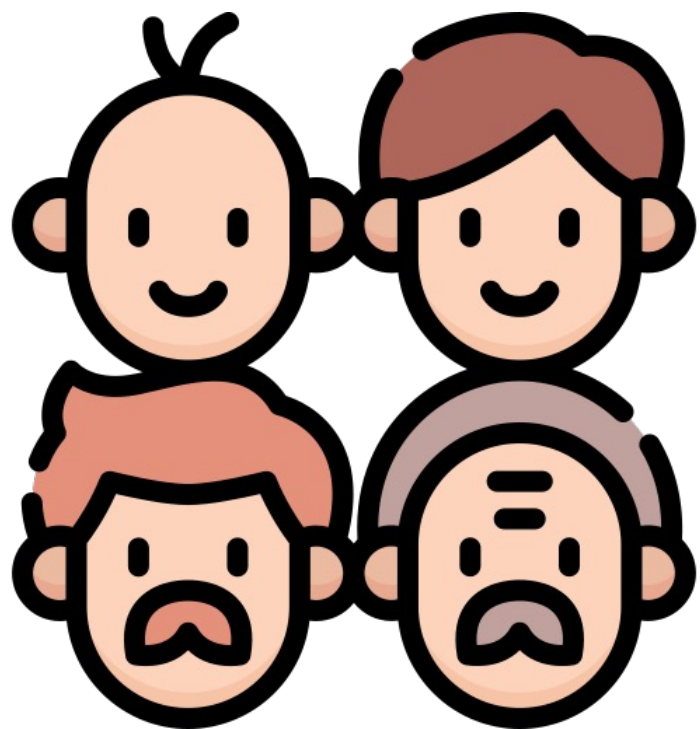
