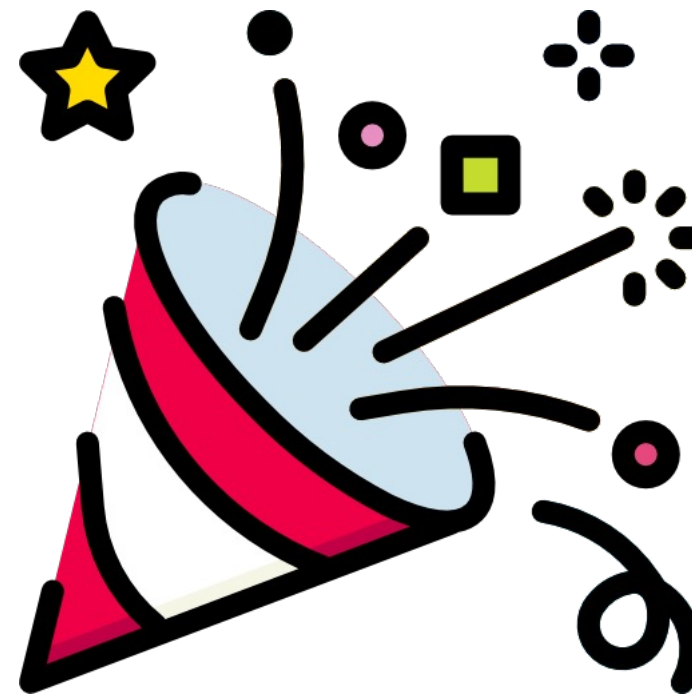
Display Slips
