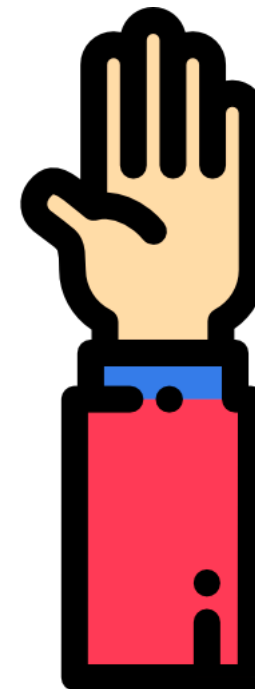
Display Slips

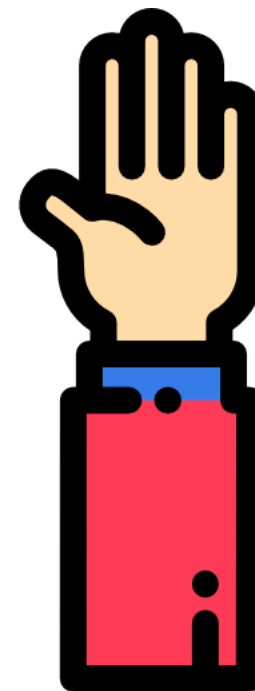
Font Variation

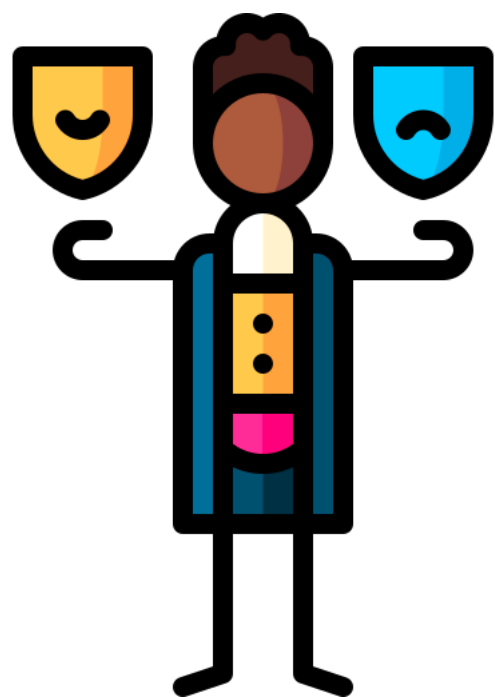

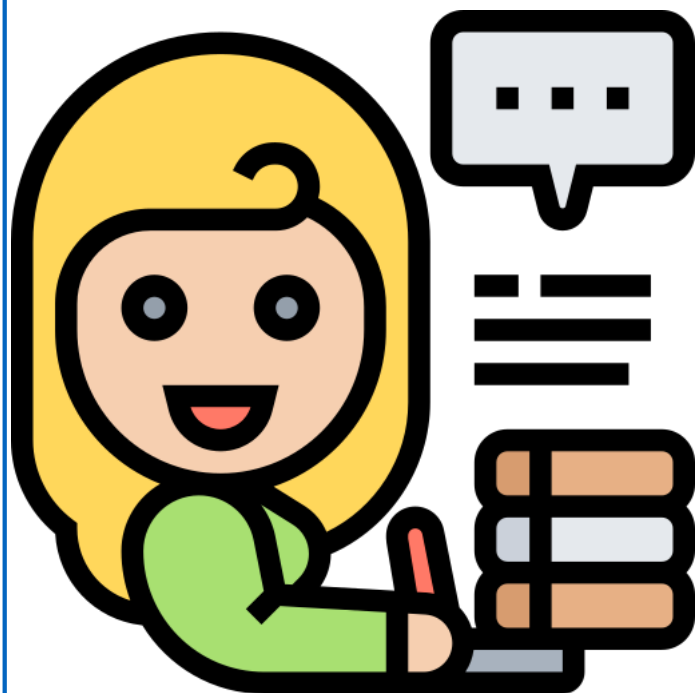
