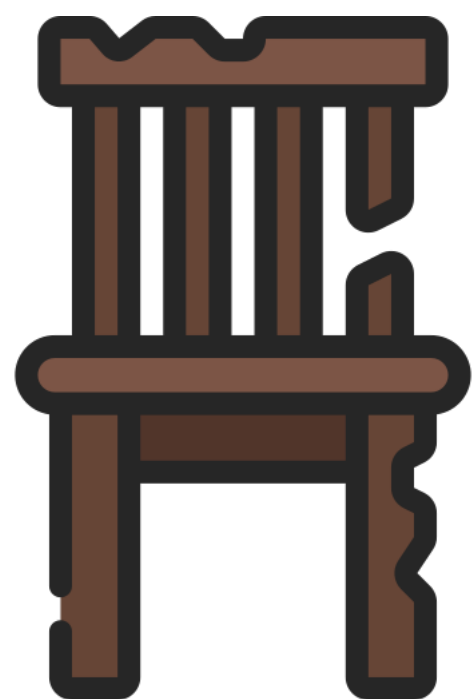
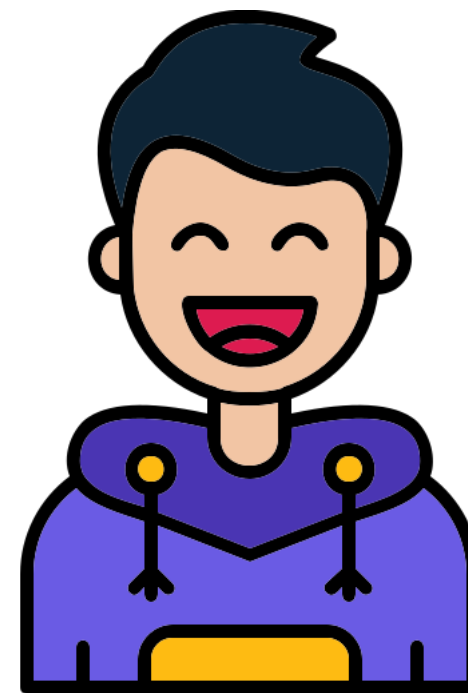
Display Slips
